

Policy Adoption

Adoption of new policies or the revision or repeal of existing policies is solely the responsibility of the Board of Education.

The Board shall adhere to the following in considering and adopting policy proposals to ensure that they are well examined before final adoption.

1. First meeting – the proposal; shall be presented, introduced and discussed as an information item.
2. Second meeting – the proposal shall be presented for a first reading, discussion and final vote.

During discussion of a policy proposal, the views of the public and staff shall be considered. Amendments may be proposed by the Board members. An amendment shall not require that the policy go through an additional reading except as the Board determines that the amendment needs further study and that an additional reading would be desirable.

Under unusual circumstances, the Board may temporarily approve a policy to meet emergency conditions. However, the above procedure is required before the policy shall be considered permanent.

In addition, the Board shall establish procedures to waive policies to facilitate attainment of school-level goals.
