

Environmental and Safety Program

It shall be the policy of the Board to guard against accidents by taking reasonable precautions to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on district property or at school-sponsored events.

The staff members shall adhere to recommended safety practices as these pertain to the school plant, special areas of instruction, student transportation, school sports, occupational safety, etc.

The practice of safety also shall be considered a facet of the instructional program of the district schools, and instruction in accident preventions well as fire prevention; emergency procedures; traffic, and bicycle and pedestrian safety shall be provided in appropriate grades and classes.

Every principal shall be responsible for the supervision of the safety program for his school. The superintendent shall have the overall responsibility for the safety program of the district. It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to see that appropriate staff members are kept informed of current state and local requirements relating to fire protection, civil defense, sanitation, public health and occupational safety.
