

Student Rights and Responsibilities

RIGHTS

RESPONSIBILITIES

Curriculum:

Students have the right to participate in adequate education programs at all levels in elementary, middle and high schools.

Students have the right to study under competent instructors in an atmosphere free from bias, prejudice and disruption.

Students have the right to appropriate counseling for personal and educational problems.

Students shall have the responsibility to strive for academic growth by participating to their utmost ability.

Students have the responsibility to contribute toward the development of a positive climate in the school that is conducive to wholesome learning and living.

Students have the responsibility to seek counseling for personal and educational problems.

Grades:

Students have the right to receive an academic grade that reflects their academic achievement and their classroom attendance.

Students have the right to be notified of unsatisfactory progress prior to the end of the grading period while sufficient time remains to take corrective action.

Students have the responsibility to maintain reasonable standards of academic performance commensurate with their ability.

Students have the responsibility to make every effort to improve their performance upon receipt of notification.

Students have the responsibility to conduct themselves in each class in ways that are conducive to the learning process.

Student records:

Students have the right to be protected by legal provisions which prohibit the release of personally identifiable information to other than legally authorized persons without the consent of the parent or eligible student.

Parents or eligible students have the responsibility to release information to those individuals or agencies who are working actively and constructively for the benefit of the student.

Parents or eligible students have the right to inspect, review and challenge the information contained in those records directly relating to the student.

Attendance:

Students have the right to attend classes appropriate to their educational level provided that infractions of school rules have not made this a restriction.

Students have the responsibility to attend all classes daily and on time unless specific circumstances prevent attendance.

Students have the right to make up work missed due to excused absences. This must be done within a reasonable period of time.

Students have the responsibility to request make-up assignments from their teachers (due to excused absences), and they must complete this work within an agreed-upon interval.
