

## **Student Protests, Demonstrations and Strikes**

Participants in sit-ins, disruptive picketing, walk-outs or other forms of disruptive behaviors shall be dealt with in the following manner:

1. The administrators shall confer with these participants and instruct them to return to class.
2. If the participants refuse to return to class, the time missed from class shall be considered unexcused.
3. If the students are disruptive in nature, the administration call in the legal authorities. If disruptive leaders are identified, they shall be suspended from one to three days, depending on their cooperation in solving the problem.
4. Non-students shall be asked to leave. Failure to do so shall result in involvement of legal authorities and the filing of charges.
